A dancer, a singer, a musician, a double bass, a xylophone, a zither out of tune, a small kalimba, five souding balls, a magic carpet and your infants from 6 to 18 months old. Radical Muzak Septet is an expansion of the accordion and turntables duo Lanz & Kocher along with a collective of Russian musicians working within the medium of experimental and improvised music. The starting point for the group is found in the development of the duet's original direction: a deep attention to listening, cutting edge technique, immediate reaction, noise textures, jagged rhythms, and sound looping. Developing as an open system located between balance and disorder Radical Muzak Septet advances specific compositions of various musical elements: acoustical sounds, selections from old archival audio recordings of accordion, sharp gestural signals and highly contrasting and dynamic coordination of sounds, noises and gestures.
